Directly outside is a public car park and the local taxi rank is 2 minutes walk. There are 6 TVs, and space for a big screen TV if the new owners wished to offer, perhaps daytime and weekend sport. The current freeholders are more than willing to offer support and training for the new owners. The property extends to some 359m2 and is fully air conditioned. Benalmadena is on the Costa del Sol in southern Spain, only 10km from Malaga airport. It is one of a number of villages along the Costa del Sol that has grown up with, and due to, tourism The light train and the bus service are excellent for getting up the coast. The Benalmadena Coast (Spanish: Benalmàdena Costa) is the southernmost portion of Benalmádena, where there are many hotels, bars, and of course beaches, and the Puerto Marina is here. It is an open-air shopping mall, marina, and on-the-water (literally) condominium complex, with shops, bars restaurants and nightclubs. Local buses run up to Benalmadena Pueblo via Arroyo de la Miel and along the coast from Malaga right down to Estepona. There are lots of local shops in Arroyo de la Miel, with many others dotted around the area.
