Alora has many tourist attractions, such as the Baroque church of the Incarnation, considered the second largest in the province, the Arab Castle, a fortress with Roman foundations that preserves interesting vestiges and alusis, or the Convent of Our Lady of Flowers, a Baroque building erected in the 16th century at a short distance from the town. In addition, it has the perfect location to visit the Caminito del Rey, an aerial path built on the walls of the Desfiladero de los Gaitanes, which is one of the main natural tourist attractions of the province of Malaga. It is also known for its gastronomy, whose dishes include the perota soup, made with pepper, onion, potato or asparagus and in whose honor is celebrated annually the gastronomic and tourist party 'Day of Soups Perotas'.
